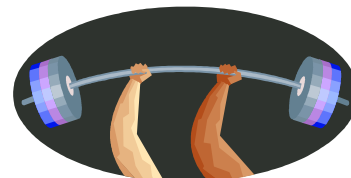
I Can't, But We Can!
